The CIA Project makes the relationship between young and old extremely positive, allowing on the one hand the development of personal and professional skills based on the exchange of knowledge and experiences between young and old through Local Intergenerational Civic Councils, with the aim of improving the employability of young people and allow them access to civic decision-making, with special reference to the group of young people who, due to their poor training, experience or level of skills development, have greater difficulties in entering the labour market.
